

Weather Summary for Antigua and Barbuda April 2010

Antigua experienced well above normal rainfall during April. The total for the month was 9.40 inches, while the normal is 3.07 inches (1971 – 2000). The rainfall total for this month was over 300% the normal total. Most of the rains for the month were caused by cold fronts and surface to low level troughs.

Coolidge mean temperature of 26.6°C or 79.9°F was above normal and the highest since 2005 and the fifth highest on record for April. Coolidge also had a minimum temperature of 22.5°C or 72.5°F which was well above normal, the highest since 1980 and the second highest on record for the month.
