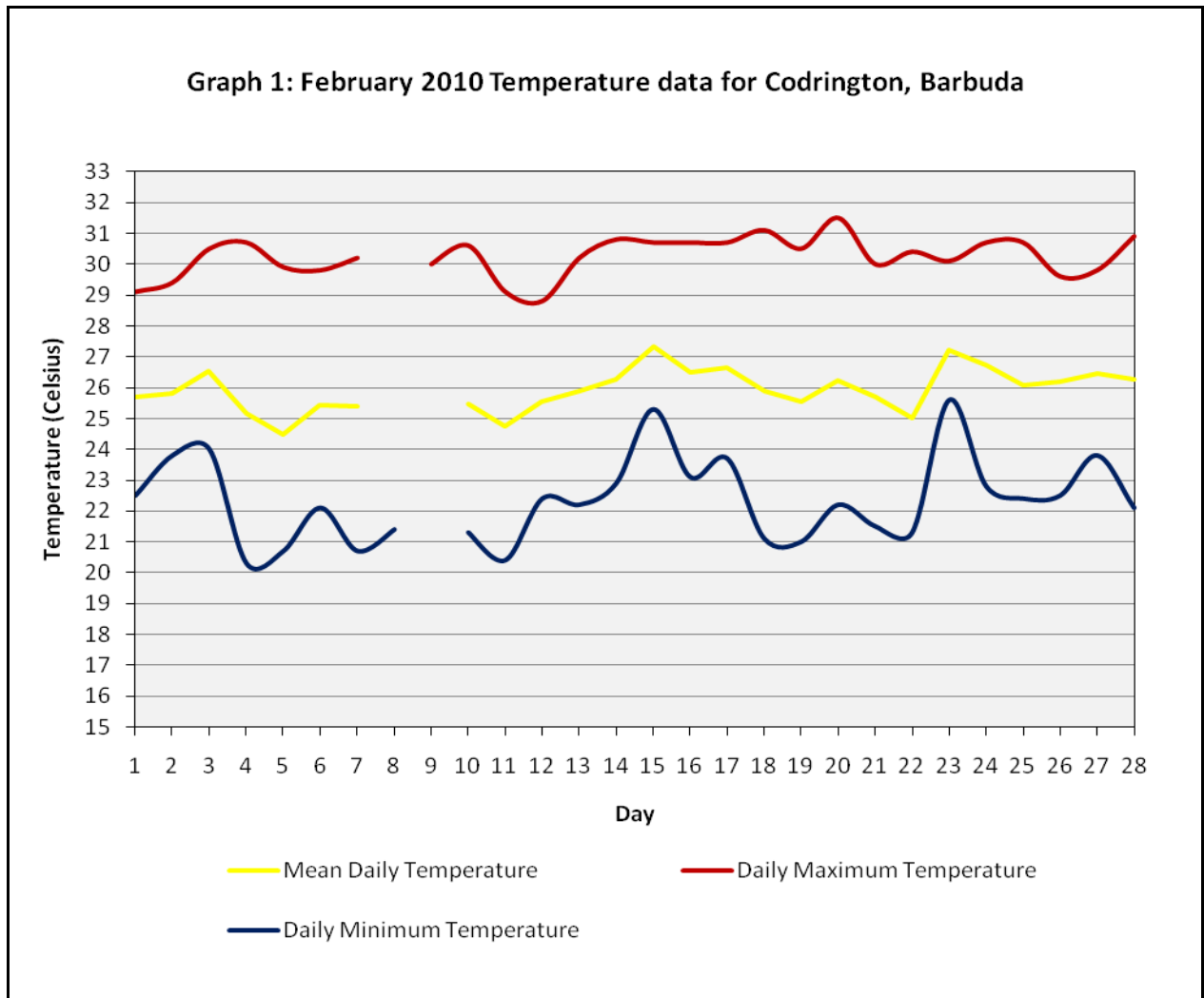


Weather Summary for Codrington, Barbuda February 2010

Codrington experienced well below period average rainfall during February. The total for the month was 0.38 of an inch as compared to the average of 2.36 inches (1993 – 2009). The rainfall total for this month was a mere 16% of the period average total. Low level trough systems contributed most to the rainfall total for February.

The mean temperature was 25.9°C. The maximum temperature was 31.5°C and the minimum was 20.3°C.
