

## Weather Summary for Antigua and Barbuda January 2010

Antigua experienced near normal rainfall during January. The total for the month was 2.35 inches, while the normal is 2.59 inches (1971 – 2000). The rainfall total for this month was 91% of the normal total. Over in Barbuda, the rainfall total was below the period average at Park. The total for the month was 1.45 inches, while the period average is 2.38 inches (1993 – 2009). Low level troughs and cold fronts contributed most to the rainfall total for January.

Coolidge had a mean temperature of 25.6°C or 78.1°F, which was above normal and the highest since 2003. Coolidge also had a maximum temperature of 31.2°C, which was well above normal and the highest ever (1971 – 2009). The temperature for Jolly Hill of 25.4°C was above the period average.
