

**Weather Summary for Antigua and Barbuda
June 2010**

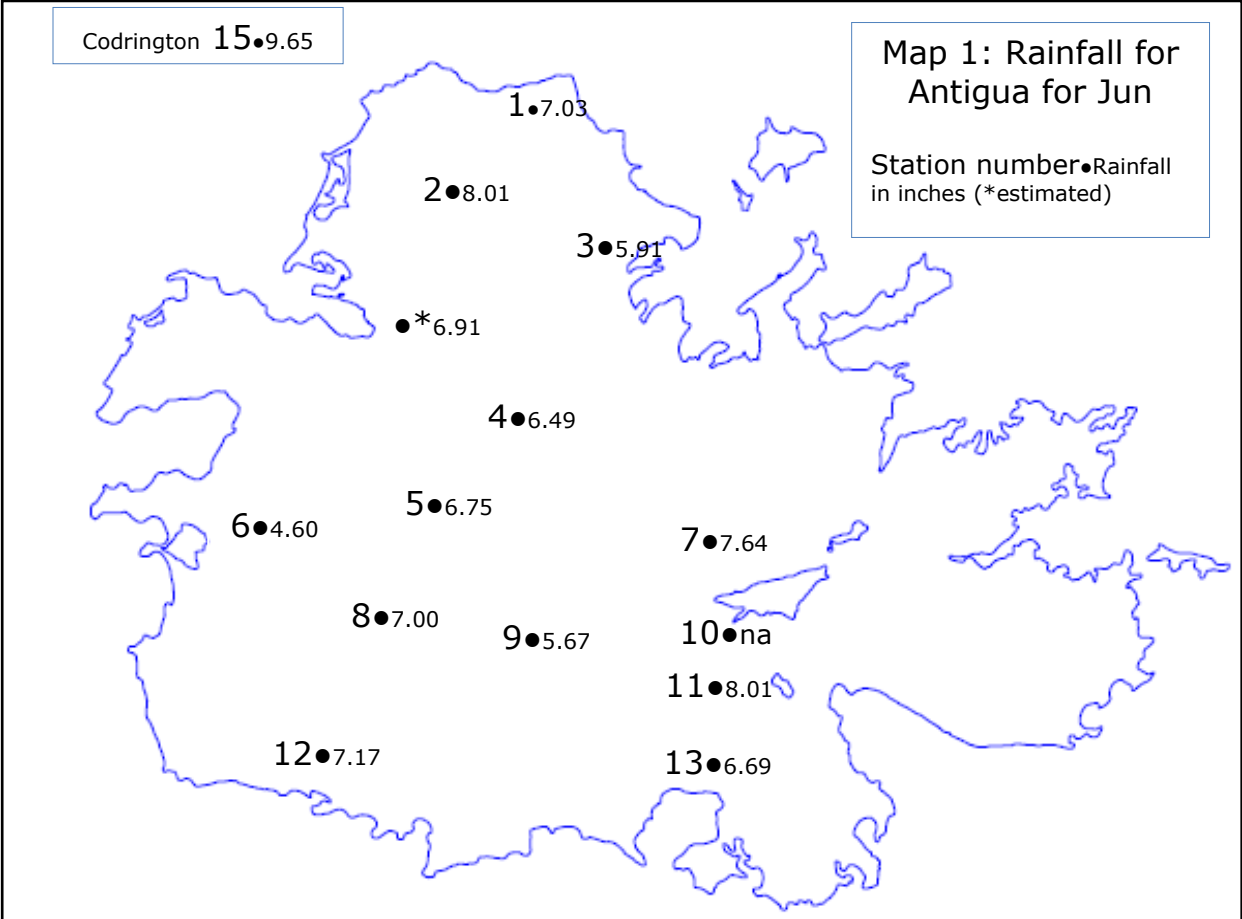

Antigua experienced well above normal rainfall during June. The total for the month was 6.33 inches, while the normal is 2.19 inches (1971 – 2000). The rainfall total for this month was over 289% the normal total. The rains for the month were due mainly to tropical waves.

The mean temperature for Coolidge of 28.2°C or 82.8°F was above normal and the sixth highest on record for June. Coolidge also had a maximum temperature of 32.5°C, which was well above normal, the highest since 1998 and the fourth highest ever.
