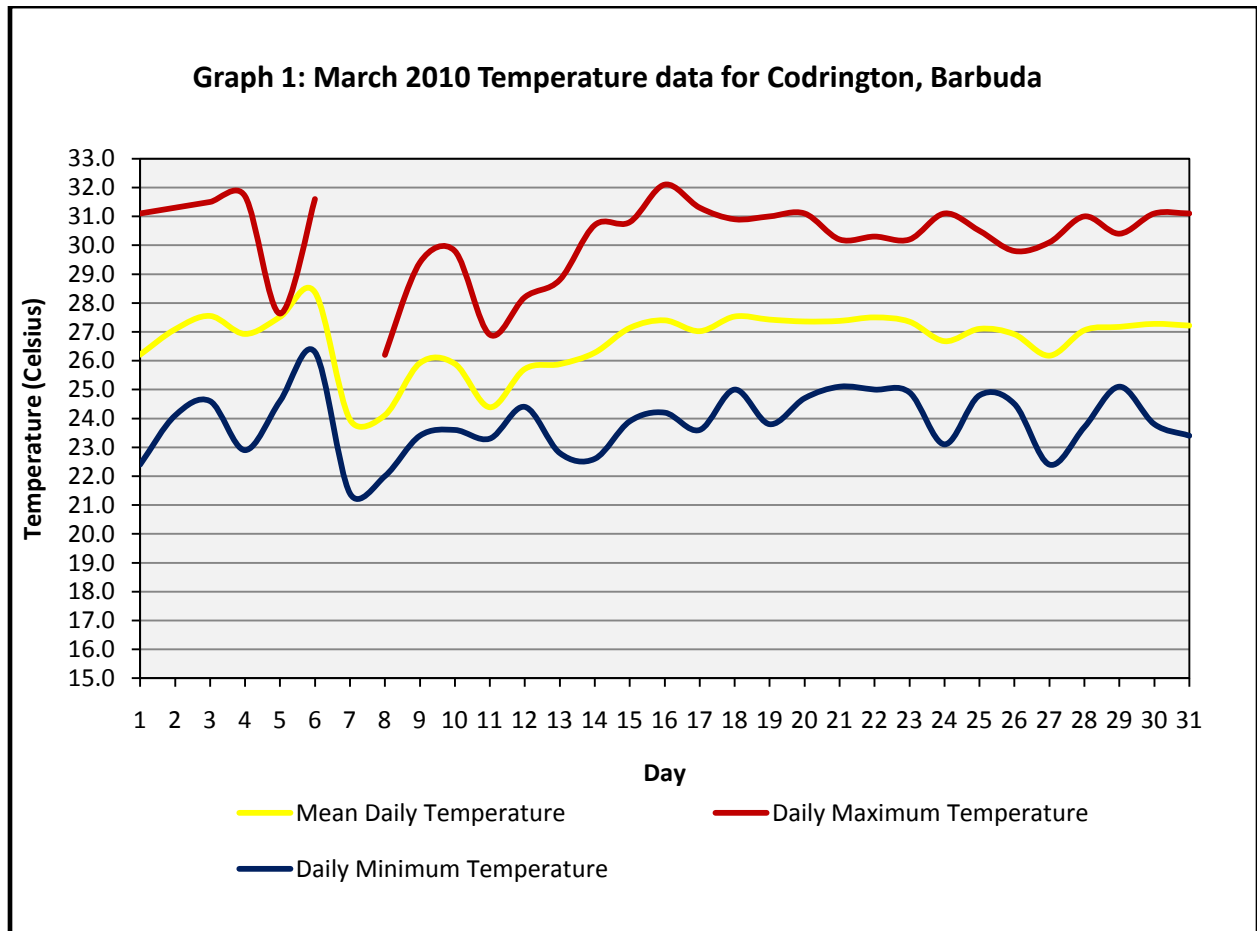


Weather Summary for Codrington, Barbuda March 2010

Codrington experienced above period average rainfall during March. The total for the month was 3.32 inches as compared to the normal figure of 1.62 inches (1993 – 2009). The rainfall total for this month was 205% of the period average total. Cold fronts contributed most to the rainfall total for the month.

The mean temperature was 26.7°C. The maximum temperature was 32.1°C and the minimum was 21.4°C.
