TROPICAL CYCLONE INFORMATION STATEMENT  
ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA METEOROLOGICAL SERVICES  
11:00 AM ECT TUE JUNE 28 2022

THIS IS FOR THE LEEWARD ISLANDS AND THE BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS.

THE ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA METEOROLOGICAL SERVICES IS FOLLOWING THE PROGRESS OF POTENTIAL TROPICAL CYCLONE TWO.

THE SYSTEM IS IN THE VICINITY OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO AND SOUTHERN THE WINDWARD ISLANDS. IN THE REASONABLE WORST-CASE, THE POTENTIAL TROPICAL CYCLONE POSES NO WIND THREAT TO ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA, THE REST OF THE LEEWARD ISLANDS AND THE BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS. NO PREPARATIONS ARE NEEDED; HOWEVER, YOU SHOULD BE PREPARED FOR THE HURRICANE SEASON.

AT 11 AM ECT, POTENTIAL TROPICAL CYCLONE TWO, WAS LOCATED ABOUT 815 MILES SOUTH-SOUTHEAST OF THE LEEWARD ISLANDS MOVING WEST AT 23 MPH.

MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS WERE NEAR 40 MPH WITH HIGHER GUSTS. THERE IS A 70 PERCENT CHANCE OF FORMATION INTO A TROPICAL CYCLONE IN 48 HOURS AND A 90 PERCENT CHANCE OF FORMATION IN 5 DAYS.

ON ITS FORECAST TRACK, THE PROBABLE TROPICAL CYCLONE IS EXPECTED TO PASS OVER THE SOUTHERN ISLANDS LATER TODAY, PERHAPS AS TROPICAL STORM BONNIE. ALTHOUGH THE THREAT FROM WINDS IS VIRTUALLY NIL FOR THE NORTHEAST CARIBBEAN, ABOVE NORMAL WINDS, INDIRECTLY RELATED TO THE SYSTEM, WILL KEEP SEAS HAZARDOUS, IN OPEN WATERS.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO TROPICAL CYCLONE ALERTS, WATCHES OR WARNINGS ARE IN EFFECT, AT THIS TIME, FOR THE AREA, AND NONE IS ANTICIPATED.

RESIDENTS SHOULD BE PREPARED FOR THE HURRICANE SEASON.
