

SEASONAL OUTLOOK FOR ANTIGUA - SEPTEMBER TO NOVEMBER 2016



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...Above to near normal rainfall...

Based upon model data, observations and subjective inputs, the following are being forecast for Antigua with respect to rainfall and temperature for September to November 2016:

Rainfall

Above to near normal **rainfall** is expected, with a confidence of 80%. The chance of drier than normal weather is slight – 20%. The **island-average rainfall** will likely be greater than **383.5 mm** (15.1 in). Probabilistically, there is a

- **50% chance of above normal rainfall;**
- 30% chance of near normal rainfall (383.5 to 530.9 mm or 15.1 to 20.9 in) and
- 20% chance of below normal rainfall.

Temperature

Equal chance of above, near or below normal **mean temperature**. Probabilistically, there is a

- 33% chance of above normal temperature;
- 33% chance of near normal temperature (27.3 °C to 27.6 °C or 81.1 to 81.7 °F) and
- 33% chance of below normal temperature.

Meanwhile, daytime **highs** and night-time **lows** are likely to be above normal and below normal respectively. At and in the vicinity of the V. C. Bird International Airport (VCBIA), the **mean maximum temperature** is likely to be higher than **30.6 °C** (88.0 °F), with a confidence of 70%; the 1981-2010 normal is 30.4 to 30.6 °C (86.7 to 87.1 °F). On the other hand, the **mean minimum temperature** is likely to be lower than 24.2 °C (75.6 °F), with a confidence of 60%; the 1981-2010 normal is 24.2 to 24.5 °C (75.6 to 76.1 °F).

Definition

The following definitions are being observed based on the 1981 to 2010 (baseline) dataset:

- **Below normal** (less or lower than normal/usual): Values in the lowest 33.3% of the dataset
- **Near normal** (normal or usual): Values in the middle 33.3% of the dataset
- **Above normal** (more or higher than normal/usual): Values in the highest 33.3% of the dataset
