...Tsunami Information Statement...

This is a Tsunami Information Statement to inform the public and authorities that, based on current data, there is no tsunami threat to Antigua and Barbuda following the recent seismic activity.

Preliminary Earthquake Parameters:

- Magnitude: 7.1
- Origin Time and Date: 6:05 pm AST (2205 UTC) June 24, 2026
- Coordinates: 10.5° North, 68.4° West
- Depth: 10 km/ 6 miles
- Location: Near the coast of Venezuela

Evaluation:

An earthquake with a preliminary magnitude of 7.1 occurred near the coast of Venezuela at 6:05 pm on Wednesday, June 24, 2026

Based on all available data, there is no significant tsunami threat from this earthquake for Antigua and Barbuda. However, there is a very small possibility of tsunami waves along the Caribbean Sea coasts located nearest the epicentre.

Recommended Actions:

- No action required.
- Stay Updated - We advise the public to stay informed by following updates from the Antigua and Barbuda Meteorological Service and other official channels.
- Preparedness Reminder - While there is no immediate risk, this is a good time to review your tsunami evacuation plans and ensure familiarity with designated safe areas, especially if you are in coastal zones.

Next Update and Additional Information:

This will be the only statement issued for this event unless additional data are received or the situation changes.
